

## **EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE COLLECTION OF THE GREEN ENERGY AUCTION ALLOWANCE (GEA-ALL) CHARGE FOR THE JULY AND AUGUST 2026 BILLING MONTHS**

With reference to NGCP Customer Bulletin 2026-29<sup>1</sup> where customers were informed of the temporary suspension of the collection of the GEA-ALL rate equivalent to PhP0.0371/kWh starting the May 2026 to June 2026 billing periods following Energy Regulatory Commission's (ERC) Press Release dated 08 May 2026 and Order on ERC Case No. 2025-127 RC<sup>2</sup> dated 01 June 2026, and the recent Order on the same case dated 06 July 2026 wherein the Commission extended for two (2) months the suspension of the collection of the GEA-All charge, covering the July and August 2026 billing months, NGCP shall continue the implementation of the temporary suspension of the GEA-All Charge to its customers until the August 2026 billing month.

**ORDER**

On 01 June 2026, the Commission issued an *Order* resolving, among others, to suspend the collection of the GEA-All charge for two (2) months, covering the May and June 2026 billing months.

Relative to the foregoing, the Commission notes that, as of 05 June 2026, the GEA-All Fund has a remaining balance of PhP707,469,835.24, which is more than sufficient to cover the estimated monthly payment requirements for eligible Renewable Energy (RE) developers for the period covering the suspension for two (2) months, even with the projected entry of five (5) additional plants into the program by July 2026.

The Commission further notes that the Philippines remains under a state of national emergency pursuant to Executive Order No. 110,<sup>1</sup> which was issued to address imminent energy security threats and supply volatility arising from geopolitical tensions in the Middle East.

In view of the foregoing and considering the healthy financial condition of the GEA-All Fund, the Commission finds it prudent to suspend the collection of the GEA-All charge for another two (2) months, covering the July and August 2026 billing months. Accordingly, the Commission shall undertake a comprehensive review of the fund status by September 2026 to determine the feasibility of further extending the suspension period.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission hereby **RESOLVES**, as follows:

1. Suspension of the collection of the GEA-All charge is hereby **EXTENDED** for two (2) months, covering the July and August 2026 billing months;
2. The Independent Electricity Market Operator of the Philippines (IEMOP) shall continue to collect and remit the Actual Cost Recovery Revenue;
3. The National Transmission Corporation (TransCo) shall continue to pay the Green Energy Tariff (GET) obligations to GET plants; and

4. Collection Agents are directed to submit formal compliance reports, which must include a transmittal letter and sample bills demonstrating the suspension of the GEA-All line item, **within fifteen (15) days** from receipt of this *Order*.
